

Hi Andrew – your email arrived in my inbox in the last 15 minutes (9.45pm-10pm).

I “hid” the post from public view shortly after our conversation, pending the call back I requested from your superior – to whom you informed me you would pass on my request. I also ‘hid’ the same post that had been shared by our family to 4 other pages. Any other shares I have no control over. I am still waiting for that call.

I also requested a copy of the suppression order, as I did not (and still don’t) see how a member of the public, who was not present at the court hearing where it was granted, can be expected to be aware of the contents of that order. I requested a copy from you, but you said the Police did not at that point have a copy.

I have read your email closely, and note you say only that the order “*Restricts the publication in any public forum of the **defendants** identity...*” it is clear that our Facebook Post only published the identity of one **victim** of the fraud – the psychiatrist from USA whose identity was stolen – not the “*defendant*”.

You stated to me – in fact you got quite annoyed when I asserted otherwise – that this issue had nothing to do with our son & brother’s death at Waikato Hospital. I’m afraid it has a lot to do with that:

- Firstly, there is a real chance that Nicky was seen by the fraudulent doctor when triaged on admission to Waikato Hospital on or shortly after 17 February 2015. We have asked the DHB if this happened, and they have not yet replied.
- Secondly, our complaint about the Hospital/DHB – both to the Police and to the Minister of Health, who has this week ordered an investigation by the Director of Mental Health into management practices at the DHB (citing Nicky’s case as one of three “serious incidents” this year) - is very much about poor management practices, such as this one. The DHB has promised full disclosure of ALL facts relating to these issues to us – we regard the employment of a fraudulent ‘psychiatrist’, **during the time Nicky was a patient there**, as very pertinent to the state of their management systems and practices.

We note with much irony that it took less than one day for the Police to act on the DHB’s complaint about our Facebook post, but that it took over two days to start a search for Nicky after he was reported as a missing person with “serious” suicidal tendencies.

We would nevertheless be happy to receive a copy of the suppression order from the police or anyone else, so we can peruse it.

Hello David

This morning I contacted you by telephone to discuss the publishing of a name on the Nicky "Autumn" Stevens face book page. The interim name suppression order made by the Hamilton District Court restricts the publication in any public forum of the defendants identity relating to the fake Psychiatrist previously employed by the Waikato DHB and currently before the Courts.

I requested that you consider the removal of the publication of the doctors name on the Nicky "Autumn" Stevens face book page and further advised you that it could be considered a breach of the current suppression order and that that was currently under review.

I understand that the posting on the Nicky "Autumn" Stevens face book page that we discussed this morning has been removed.

My thanks for the actions taken in relation to the request from Police.

This investigation relating to the Psychiatrist employed by Waikato DHB is in its early stages. It is a challenging investigation that has a long way to go and we thank you for your compliance with our request.
